California State University, Northridge (CSUN) is located in northern Los Angeles, less than 30 minutes from Hollywood, Beverly Hills, Universal Studios, Santa Monica and Pacific Ocean beaches. Northridge is a comfortable residential community in the suburbs of Los Angeles. CSUN is home to more than 30,000 students, making the university one of the 50 largest in the U.S.A.

Conditional Admission

If you do not yet have the required acceptable English Proficiency Exam score for admission to CSUN, you may wish to consider applying for Conditional Admission. This status enables academically and financially qualified students to study English in the Intensive English Program (IEP) until they are able to satisfy the English-language proficiency requirement of the university.

Intensive English Program

The CSUN Intensive English Program (IEP), offered through The Tseng College, provides full-time English-language instruction to international students. Classes in reading and writing, speaking and listening, TOEFL preparation, various elective courses, and free tutoring are included. Advanced IEP students may take university classes while in the IEP.

Semester at CSUN Program

The Semester at CSUN Program allows international students, who have fulfilled TOEFL or IELTS requirements, to take university classes at California State University, Northridge full-time for one or two semesters. Students choose classes in their areas of interest, study with American and other international students and earn credits for successfully completed classes.
