CSUN Admissions Information

FOR FRESHMEN – Students attending a college or university for the first time can apply if they meet the following basic criteria:

- ✓ 3.0 grade-point average (GPA)
- ✓ English-language proficiency scores of 5.5* on the IELTS, 61 on the TOEFL iBT, 45 on the PTE Academic, or 5.0 on the iTEP

FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS – Entry requirements for graduate programs vary by department.

Typical minimum requirements include the following:

- \checkmark 3.0 GPA in the applicant's previous university degree program
- ✓ English-language proficiency scores: 6.0* on the IELTS or 79 on the TOEFL iBT, 58 on the PTE Academic

Note: Graduate departments may require higher scores than the minimums listed above, and some departments require separate departmental applications.
