California State University, Northridge's Master of Social Work (MSW) program provides advanced preparation for students who seek careers focused on addressing the social services needs of people.

## The MSW curriculum

- Prepares graduates to work successfully within a variety of environments, cultures and organizational systems;
- Emphasizes critical and creative thinking that enables graduates to initiate, evaluate and adapt interventions appropriate to the relevant contexts – local, regional, national or global; and
- Creates a context for professional, ethical and effective practice by incorporating content on the profession's history, philosophy and values.

While CSUN's MSW is a 60-unit degree, students who participate in online and off-campus cohorts may be required to complete additional units to meet the specific Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) fieldwork requirements for each cohort/location.

## MSW Field Education

CSUN's MSW program features a substantial field-education component that enables students to apply the concepts and practice the skills learned in their coursework as well as experience their own effectiveness in a variety of situations.

In addition to academic classes, students begin their 16 hours per week of internship (scheduled weekdays during regular business hours) starting their first term of the program.
