

## PROGRAM ESTIMATE and FINANCIAL SUPPORT DOCUMENT (for F-1 Students)

All F-1 students are required to provide document evidence of financial support when submitting a program application. This evidence of financial support is required before a Form I-20 can be issued.

The source of financial support may be the student, a private sponsor (family member, friend, or private institution), or a public agency (embassy, home government, public institution, religious organization, etc.).

The document evidence of financial support, must be as follows:

- If the student will be sponsored by self (student) or private sponsor, the document evidence of financial support **must be a current official bank statement or bank letter** that verifies the program’s minimum financial funding amount, included below, in liquid assets and must be dated no earlier than **6 months** from the date of application submission.
- If the student will be sponsored by public agency, the document evidence of financial support must be provided by the agency as a written verification that the costs will be covered, on agency letterhead. Sponsorship statements should reflect the semester and year of the application.

***The supporting financial documentation must be uploaded to the program application and must match the name listed under the source of funding.***
