THE PURPOSE OF CSUN'S TSENG COLLEGE WITHIN THE CSUN MISSION

- ❖ The purpose of the Tseng College: Graduate, International and Midcareer Education (College) is to create new CSUN self-support programs, to continuously review and improve ongoing programs, and to increase the inclusive academic excellence and the equity-minded forefront focus of CSUN's self-support programs. In the development and refinement of CSUN's self-support programs, the College also seeks to enhance equity, engage and highlight the influence of CSUN faculty teaching, research/scholarship, and creative activities across disciplines and fields of professional practice; and broaden the understanding and appreciation of humankind's full and shared intellectual heritage across time and culture in which the CSUN learning community is deeply rooted and to which the College is deeply committed.
- Guided by CSUN's academic mission, current and emerging academic strengths, leadership principles, and planning priorities, the College is dedicated to working with CSUN faculty from all CSUN academic colleges, departments, and CSUN's extended regional, national, and international networks of relationships and the links within and across disciplines and fields of practice to find highly effective educational responses to the professional practice, equity challenges, and opportunities facing those CSUN serves regionally, nationally, and internationally. The College is a significant component of CSUN's overall educational capacities that allow it to reach a wider range of learners across the career span, enhance its innovative capabilities, and expand its educational reach regionally and globally. The College is committed to working as a fully engaged member of the CSUN community to the advantage of CSUN and those it serves.
- Fulfilling the purpose of the College requires a commitment to engaging the essential diversity of minds, modes of thinking and ways of seeing, spirits, hearts, experiences, backgrounds, cultures, abilities, and innovative insights that the College comprises to develop, sustain, and deploy important versatile and creative capacities that allow CSUN and its faculty to respond effectively to the changing educational needs of midcareer professionals/working adults, employers, communities, professional associations,

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economic and community development organizations, and international students and partners.

- ❖ Working collaboratively with CSUN's faculty, their colleagues across institutional and national lines, forefront scholars, creative professionals, and leading practitioners, the College's staff shape responses to educational needs through data-informed new approaches to what higher education can and should be in a contemporary context in ways that allow CSUN and its faculty to explore a wider range of possibilities in the more agile context of self-support in the CSU and, in turn, to deliver innovative degree and non-degree programs that are carefully and equitably crafted to allow students to achieve significant educational outcomes in programs for which inclusive excellence is a defining feature.

 - reflective, ethical, and equitable professional practice across fields and disciplines;
 - the role of the sciences in informing today's choices and in shaping our shared future;

- and protecting and expanding the ability of all individuals to realize their full potential.
- ❖ The College develops, continuously improves, and supports agile administrative systems and strategies, and thoughtfully develops and implements support services focused on the success of those that the College serves, making it possible for CSUN's college partners working with the Tseng College to have a larger creative space in which to craft programs and expand the educational options that CSUN offers. The College's staffing structure is intentionally designed to attract, support, and enhance the high talent needed to explore and embrace the positive possibilities in new technologies and systems. The College openly shares its innovative progress and ideas with the CSUN community as a means to enhance CSUN's overall capabilities.

HOW THE COLLEGE IMPLEMENTS ITS PURPOSE AND VALUE IN ITS WORK

- ❖ The College engages CSUN partner colleges, CSUN faculty members, faculty from other well-respected institutions, noted national and international scholars, and accomplished practitioners to develop new programs that explore and respond to the changing nature of practice in a given field, as well as the evolution of the related discipline and their cross-disciplinary connections, collaboratively considered—in light of the educational focus and learning goals of a program—the best use innovative and effective instructional strategies and assignment design, as well as educational technology applications to expand the reach and influence of CSUN's programs, and research designed to advance professional education and post-degree workforce education.
- ❖ The College encourages, supports, and brings together scholarship and teaching across the disciplines to develop and deliver programs that address the educational needs of those called upon to address current and emerging challenges and opportunities that will shape the future of the Greater Los Angeles Area, surrounding counties, and beyond.
- ❖ The College expands access to CSUN by working with CSUN faculty and leading professionals to develop CSUN programs and services and to offer/deliver those programs in cohort formats with integrated curricula that foster engaged learning communities. The College offers accessible schedules (e.g. evenings, weekends, and semi-asynchronous), in innovative modalities (such as online, hybrid, on-campus, and off-campus), and provides specialized and responsive support services for midcareer/working adults and organizations that otherwise may not have access to CSUN in its more traditional context.
- ❖ The College develops productive and highly collaborative partnerships with key regional, national, and international organizations, communities, and institutions designed to expand the sustained educational impact and influence of CSUN programs while providing mutually beneficial links between CSUN and organizations with complementary educational and/or research missions and values.
- ❖ The College develops long-term, mutually beneficial, and supportive internal partner relationships with CSUN's academic colleges, departments, centers, institutes, and support/administrative units. These relationships increase the number and quality of programs offered by CSUN through the College and provide a sustained financial return to internal partners—a return that helps to facilitate increases in full-time faculty in fields related to current and planned self-support programs. It allows them to invest in the professional development of faculty teaching in current or planned self-support programs, enhance support services for students in CSUN self-support programs, and build additional capacity relevant to the continuous improvement of ongoing self-support programs, as well as the development of new programs.
- ❖ The College has developed the organizational capacities and abilities needed by CSUN to create and sustain excellent, distinctive, and successful (in terms of student achievement and financial stability) international, career-long, and lifelong learning programs and services in a competitive marketplace. These capacities and abilities include but are not limited to: excellent client and student support services for working adults (from application to

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graduation), organizations and international students; on-site, hybrid, modular, and online program support services management; transparent financial management; innovative instructional design; information systems/services and data reporting and analysis; predictive analytics; market research; assessment of program effectiveness; instructor support and professional development; creative and sophisticated data-informed outreach, marketing and public relations; financial aid services; external and alumni relations, and partnerships development; online program production and technical support; applications, admissions, and registration services; international student application, registration services, and forward-thinking; international educational partnership; and collaborative College leadership with a CSUN perspective.

- ❖ The College, in keeping with CSUN principles and values and those of the broader world of higher education, ensures its ability to do its work through responsible, inclusive, and innovative management of the organization. This is achieved through the development of a co-creative and agile College working culture with a focus on innovation and creative responses to educational needs, guided by the College's established purpose and values.
