


International Student Success Pathway

- Minimum of 3.0 high school GPA for for first-time freshmen, based on a 4.0 grading system from an accredited institution.
- · Applicants must be at least 18 years old.
- Meet one of the accepted CSUN English-language proficiency minimum scores for the Pathway program.
