After the last day of a session, you have a 60-day grace period to leave the United States or to transfer to another school.

If you transfer out before completing all of the session(s) you have paid for, you are NOT eligible for a refund of any tuition paid. Exception: IEP students admitted to CSUN.

Submitting this form, along with written proof of admission to another school, confirms that you want and expect to be transferred to the school indicated on this form.

Students who travel out of the U.S. while between schools must use the new school's I-20 to reenter the U.S. If you plan to travel while between schools, work with your new school to see how to receive your new I-20, either before you leave the US or while out of the country, so that you can use it to re-enter the United States.

NOTE:

Requests received during the last week of a student's grace period will still be accepted but there is no guarantee that the request can be processed before the 60-day grace period ends.

SEVIS transfers can be processed in advance. A transfer can be requested and proof of admission can be submitted weeks or months before the end of the current semester or session. However, the actual RELEASE DATE is scheduled for the last day of school or up to 60 days after that day. The new school cannot issue the new I-20 until the release date, but they can see the names of students, and their release dates, of those who are transferring into their school in SEVIS.
