

Helpful Travel Information for You

Carry this with you when you travel.

Before leaving the US, you should give family or friends your information below to enable them to search for your whereabouts in case of emergency:

- Itinerary (travel plans, flight number, etc.),
- Passport number, and
- Date of Birth

When returning to the U.S., make sure you have all required documentation in your possession; do not put these items in your luggage, keep them with you!

- The endorsed I-20
- A valid visa
- A current passport that is valid for at least 6 months after the date of reentry

In addition, Customs and Border Protection recommends that you also have these with you:

- Evidence of financial resources
- Evidence of student status (recent tuition receipts, transcripts);
- Proof of payment of the SEVIS I-901 fee
- Names and contact information for one or more Designated School Officials (DSOs) at your school.

Notes:

1. Students transferring in SEVIS <u>must</u> use the new school's I-20 to reenter the United States.

- 2. You can leave the United States without an endorsed I-20, but you must have an endorsed (signed) I-20 to reenter the U.S. This means that you can request to have an endorsed I-20 sent to you, if necessary.
- 3. This form is for travelling when classes are NOT in session. If you will miss any classes due to travel, do NOT use this request form.
